BUNKER STABILISATION

Product: BunkerMat

New Zealand's newest golf club, Pegasus Golf Club is an 18 hole Parkland style course located within the town of Pegasus, on the edge of Pegasus Bay just 25 kilometres north of Christchurch. Designed by Kristine Kerr of Boffa Miskell it officially opened on December 5th, 2009.

On this site the prevailing winds from the North East can produce erosive forces of sand movement around the bunkers. Using **BunkerMat** means less sand is required as the sand is trapped within the open structure of the fibres. This increases the incline with which the sand can be held. **BunkerMat** also acts as a filtration barrier which limits the migration of fines from the sub soil rising to the base of the bunker and contaminating the sand, making them unplayable. As a result there is less need for maintenance and reduces the need for sand replacement.

There are better places to play than in bunkers, however as Pegasus Golf Course has 64 bunkers, there is a good chance you could end up in one.

Adam Jones from Grass Ltd comments: *"the **BunkerMat** was easy to install. We installed **BunkerMat** on approx. 20 bunkers on the high faces only. This has assisted the sand to stay in place and prevented wash outs in heavy down pours. The course has been in play since the 5th December, 2009 and with the assistance of the **BunkerMat**, we feel we have reduced our maintenance cost in placing wash down sand by as much as 75%".*
